SQUADRON HISTORY

1 June thru 30 June 1945

General:

Ten combat missions and one radar reconnaissance mission were conducted by the 45th Bombardment Squadron during the month of June.

"With the completion of sixty days of the ninety "blitz" the Island Empire of Japan was a blazing chain of destruction from Tokyo to the southern tip of Kyushu. The principle cities and industries of Japan had been repeatedly hit with thousands of tons of fire spreading bombs dropped from the giant bombers. enemy air power appeared to diminish with every strike conducted by the 20th Air Force. The most logical reasoning behind this would be that Japan was conserving her remaining air strength to resist the apparently inevitable all out invasion by the Allied Forces. Suicidal tactics seemed to be the trend of tactics employed by the Japanese. Japanese propagandists announced that new aircraft would soon be in the air to fight America's B-29's and assured the world that the Japanese people were "determined to die in defending the empire. Civilian volunteers are banding together from Japan proper to Singapore into one group with the same spirit which defeated Genghis Khan's Mongolian invasion 700 years ago and that spirit is as fierce as ever!"

Night and day the Japanese radio exhorted the people to constitute themselves a special attack (suicide) corps 100,000,000 strong. Speakers hammered at them to convert the home island into one great Rabaul, the bomb-blasted Japanese base on the tip of New Britain. The government made plans to draft men from 15 to 60 and women from 17 to 45 into the Civilian Volunteer Corps which would serve as suicidal home guard. Lieutenant General Sanetsune Ushijima, Vice Director of the Tokyo Civilian Volunteer Corps, sternly told the women they are expected to engage in active combat in emulation of the women of Okinawa who, he claimed, "fought valiantly at the front lines with their babies in their arms".

That all this sounded somewhat ridiculous to Americans was beside the point. The battle of Okinawa had reinforced the lesson learned over and over all the way across the Pacific; the up-side down Japanese mind could make the cost of conquest terribly expensive in American lives.

Some examples of suicidal defensive tactics are cited from the final stages in the Battle of Okinawa: In waves of rage and frustration, scores of Japanese jumped into the sea, or blew out their brains with grenades. One Japanese

soldier popped up near an American artillery position, shouted at the startled doughboys in good English: "Look out, I'm going to blow my head off" - and did. One group of 21 enemy soldiers raced around in circles screaming wildly, ran back behind a boulder to hold a conference and finally blasted themselves to bits. Another maddened Jap decided to have one last fling at the Americans before dying. He came forward with his hands over his head as if to surrender. When he was within ten feet of an American Captain, he suddenly stooped over, picked up a handful of dirt and tossed it into the Officer's face. Doughboys standing nearby nearly drilled the Jap as he turned to walk away.

Although the above incidents had no direct bearing to the Twentieth Air Force's strategic bombing of Japan, these facts were presented as a preview to the sanguine warfare that appeared to be inevitable following the bombing which was intended to soften the Japanese defenses for the invasion forces.

Personnel in the squadron were keenly interested in the new policy of returning combat crews and non flying enlisted men to the continental United States. Combat crew members who had completed 35 missions were eligible to return home for discharge from the Army, for 30 days leave or furlough, or for 30 days detached service, depending on the individual's plans and wishes for getting out of the service as soon as possible, staying in until the defeat of Japan or making the Army a career. Non-flying enlisted personnel were eligible to be returned home provided they had enough points, 85 being the critical score. In this category all of the enlisted men were those who wanted to get out of the Army as soon as possible. Some of the enlisted men had enough points, but preferred to stay in the Army until Japan's final defeat, or to make a career of it. No policy had been announced for non flying officer personnel.

Effective 3 June 1945 it was no longer necessary for the Officers and enlisted men to eat in the same crowded mess hall. The Officers started eating at their own newly constructed mess hall at this time.

Construction of quonset huts was started for Officers and enlisted men on combat crews. It was said that ground enlisted men and officer personnel were to live in prefabricated huts to be constructed at a later date.

The health of the men of the squadron was at a high level, and, if such an intangible thing as squadron morale as a whole can be accurately judged the morale was good.

Orderly Room:

Ocean swimming continued to be the principal form of recreation. No organized recreation had been set up for sports such as tennis, volleyball, and softball. The fast pace of bombing operations made it untimely to institute such a program.

Lt. JAMES DECOSTER and T/Sgt Edward Cox spent several days at a rest camp in Oahu, Hawaii. These were the first to attend such a rest camp and they were very enthusiastic over it.

The "over 42 years of age" regulation went into effect and three enlisted men, S/Sgt Hatten, Sgt Sheehan, and Cpl Hill were transferred to the United States for discharge.

3. Modifications on new aircraft:

Aircraft received during the month did not incorporate any modifications that were not on aircraft received the previous month.

4. Major work accomplished:

Twenty six engines were changed during the month, six of which were accomplished by the newly organized engine change crew. The average time in use for these twenty six engines was 266 hours and 35 minutes; however, sixteen of them were in use well over 500 hours which represented a tremendous improvement over that obtained in India.

Ten missions were flown by the Squadron which included 102 completed sorties by Squadron aircraft. There were nine aborts or early returns. The average flying time per assigned aircraft was 117 hours and 35 minutes.

5. Modifications on old aircraft:

Current Technical Order and C. T. I. modifications were being accomplished as rapidly as kits became available.

6. Principal trouble:

The main source of trouble experienced was the lack of sufficient personnel, tools and equipment to properly maintain the sixteen assigned aircraft. An average of five men were assigned to each aircraft with about three to four available for duty each day. It was doubtful if the pace of ten missions per month and an average time per assigned aircraft of 117 hours could be maintained under these conditions.

Armament:

1. The only changes in armament equipment during the month was the removal of the short round eliminator. This had been the cause of a few ammunition jams. Another change was the discontinued use of tracer ammunition.

2. New aircraft assigned to the squadron during the month had no new modifications other than those described in Day's historical record.

3. Aircraft 42-24739 had a lower turret which failed to fire in the air, but

which was later ground checked and found to be functioning properly. This presented a very difficult problem, because everything the maintenance men checked was in proper working order. Electrical connections were tightened and this turret worked perfectly with every test that was made in flight as well as on the ground.

Aircraft 42-24718 shot out its own engine and was forced to land at Iwo Jima. Guns were covered with an asphalt base rust preventive, even so all twelve guns had to be replaced.

4. One note of interest was the outstanding effort made to get aircraft 46-25274 airborne on a mission. Two hours before the deadline for take off the section loaded 164 M47A2 incendiary bombs and completed the fuelling in thirty nine minutes. This was a record time. However, the aircraft did not take off because of a leak discovered in the center wing tank caused by a piece of flak.

5. The biggest problem encountered again this month was the indecision on the use of an extra bomb bay tank. Also, the lack of 24 volt power units made it difficult to load at night because of insufficient light.

Communications:

Squadron radio maintenance during the month of June was merged with Group maintenance personnel in a Group shop. Maintenance problems were discussed and information pertaining to corrective measures was made available to all radio mechanics.

During the month several instances of VHF failure were found in which wires were found to be shorting out to their shielding in the internal wiring of the aircraft.

A major trouble found during the month was the microphone switches shorting out, thereby shorting the interphone system in the aircraft. The only remedy was to replace the switch.

Radar:

During the month of June an intensive course of training was initiated for all radar operators. Radar maintenance was emphasized in this training. It was believed that with this additional training the results obtained during missions would be highly improved as the radar operator would have a much better idea of the set. He would also be able to analyze any troubles that might develop in flight and perform the proper maintenance quickly and efficiently.

New aircraft arrived from the United States with newer and improved equipment. One of the newest modifications was an anti-jamming circuit which would greatly diminish the interference which previously greatly handicapped operation.

In a drive to improve I.F.F. operation a new test set was built by the radar section which would greatly improve the test given the I.F.F. before a mission. The previous test set had proved to be highly unsatisfactory, as it did not give a good check on the set's sensitivity. Therefore, sets that checked satisfactorily on the ground were not efficient enough to give a response to a ground

interrogation. The new test set registered a good measurement of the overall I.F.F. sensitivity and with the use of this test set the I.F.F. violations were expected to diminish greatly.

A new test scope was designed by the radar section to calibrate the AN/AP-4 on the ground. This set was portable and much lighter than the scope formerly used. After several modifications further tests were to be made this test scope.

New mock ups of all radar equipment were being built in the radar shop. It was expected that these would be of great assistance in checking out set components before they were installed in the aircraft.

Ordnance:

This section functioned very smoothly with nothing happening that had not been experienced before.

Master Sergeant James E. Gore deserved a lot of credit for the excellent job accomplished by his ordnance section during the absence of the Ordnance Officer from 20 December 1944 to 3 June 1945. During this period M/Sgt Gore had all the headaches of packing and shipping the ordnance equipment and men via water from India to the new Pacific base at Tinian.

Very soon after arriving at Tinian M/Sgt Gore was called upon to service aircraft in an unprecedented "blitz" of combat operations. At the beginning of the operations the section had received only part of its necessary equipment for the handling of bombs, and was faced with the problem of handling new types of incendiary clusters never before used, the E-46 incendiary cluster and the E-48 incendiary cluster, in quantities that at first staggered the imagination.

The ordnance section was also unfamiliar with the new M-27 bomb service truck new to the squadron. Breakdowns were frequent. However, M/Sgt Gore, facing all these problems and shouldering full responsibility for the section, always delivered the goods on time, and none of the aircraft were ever delayed on a mission for lack of bombs and ammunition.

Schools and Training

During the month of June the combat crews were kept busy in various phases of combat training. In between missions the crews, in addition to the class room work, participated in combat training missions. The lead crews ordinarily were scheduled for such missions every second day between combat missions, and the other crews flew practice missions from time to time, but on no set schedule. When the replacement crews had been thoroughly indoctrinated in the class rooms for missions, training missions were scheduled. All crews were subject for assignment to fly radar reconnaissance and photo missions. Only after thorough indoctrination in all phases of combat training were the new crews assigned to participate in the combat missions.

Some of the training courses were conducted solely for the education of the replacement crews and some classes were only for old combat crews,

and other classes were conducted for both types of crews jointly. All during the month navigators from various crews were schooled in the use of the Loran at the 58th Wing Training Section. All navigators were to be given the training.
